I'm going to show you how to use it. It's dead simple so that you can create a presentation of your work in seconds. Let's start!

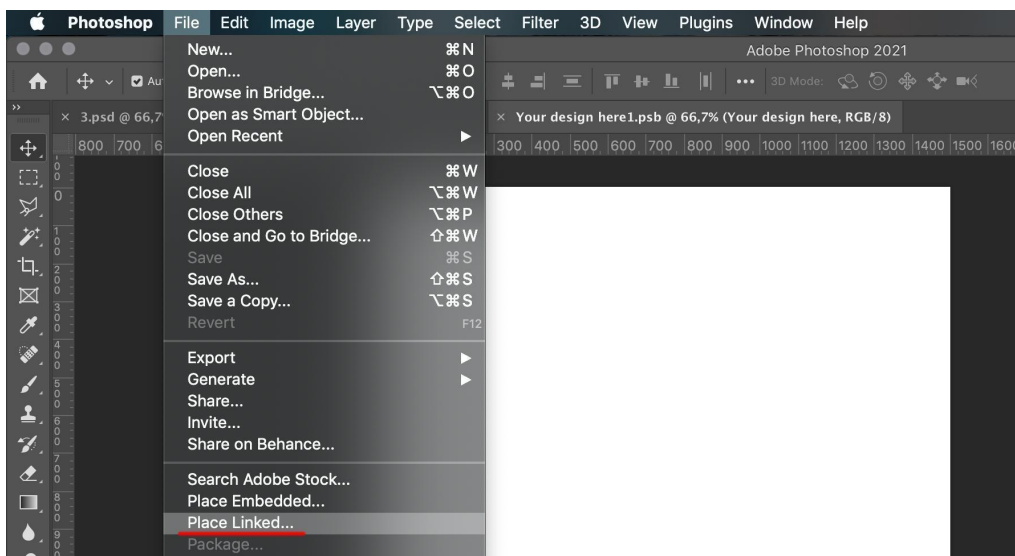
HOW TO PLACE YOUR DESIGN INTO A PSD MOCK-UP

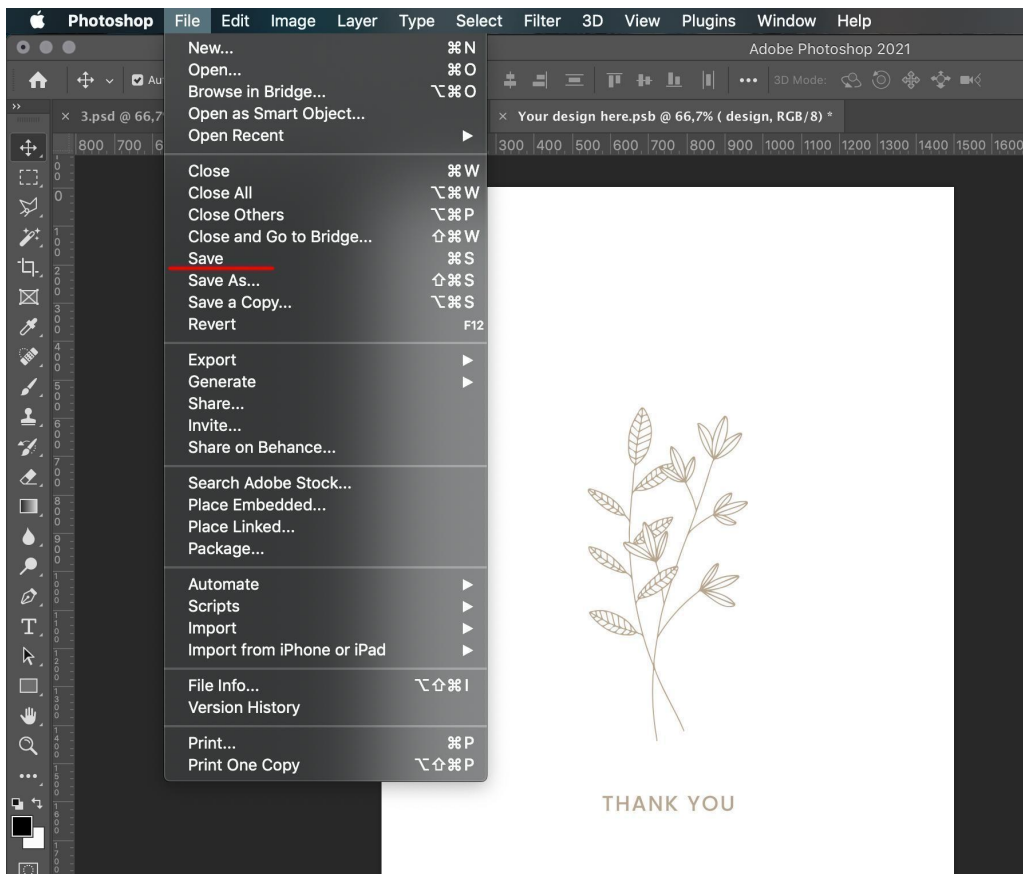
1. Open the PSD file in Photoshop. Double-click on the thumbnail of the 'Your Design Here' layer in the Layers palette. It is highlighted in red. If you don't see it, open the folder. Photoshop will open a new document in a new window.



2. Click File > Place Linked and navigate to the file on your computer. Later, if you make any changes in the file with your design, it'll be updated in mockups. Want to place your design as embedded? Just drag and drop it into the window you just opened.



3. Scale your design as you want. Go to File, then click Save or Ctrl+S (for PC) or Cmd+S (for Mac). Then close this tab. Now your image is placed into the mock-up.

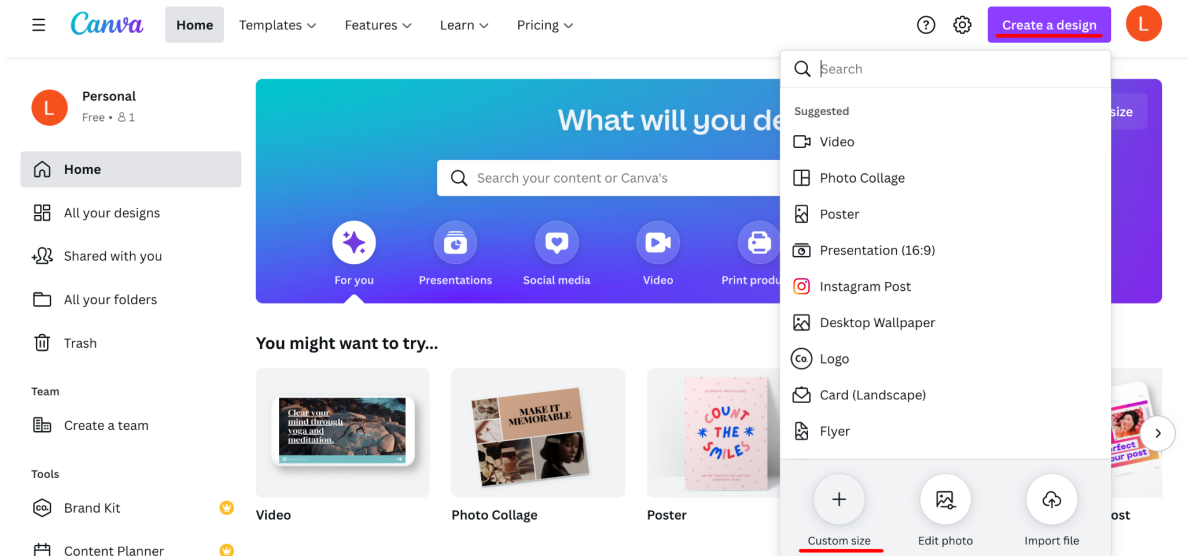


HOW TO TO PLACE YOUR DESIGN USING CANVA

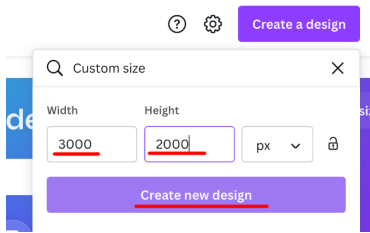
Don't have Photoshop? Just use Canva.

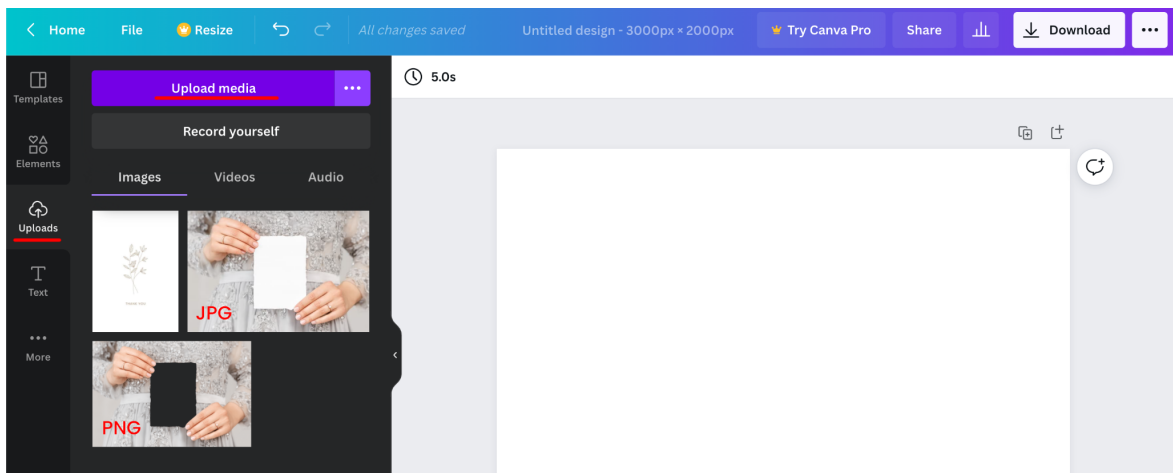
1. Go to www.canva.com. You need to have a Canva account (the best part: it's free).
2. Click Create a design, then Custom size.



3. Enter any size you need.

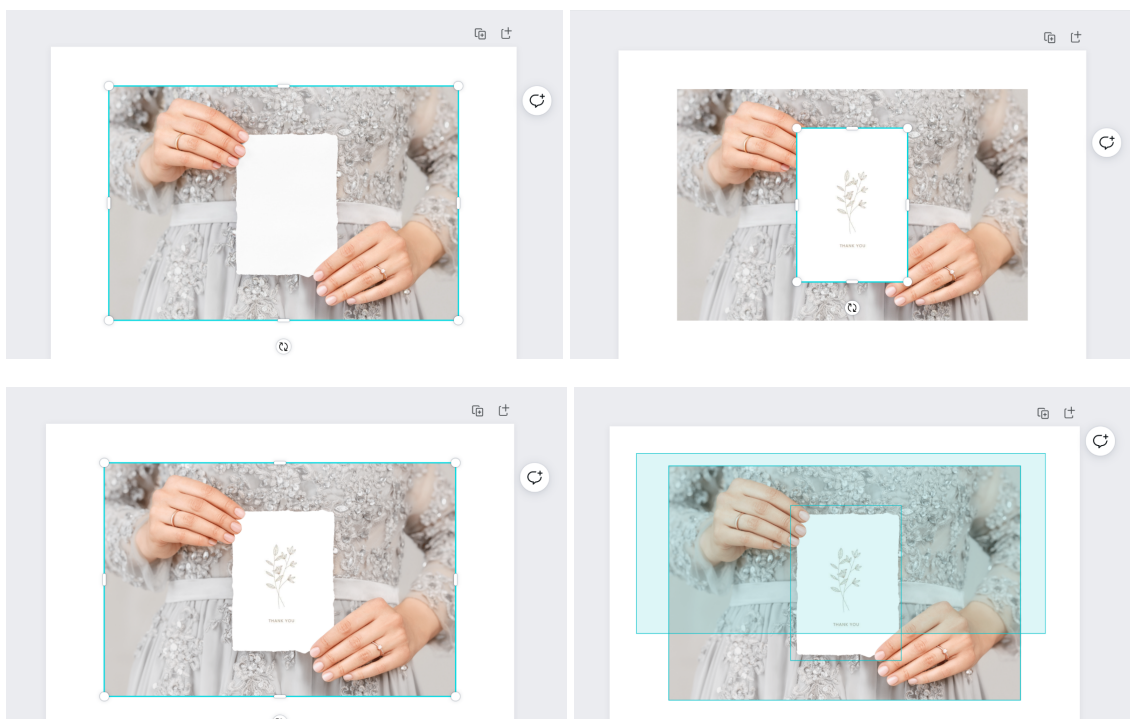


4. Click Uploads (on the left) and then Upload media.



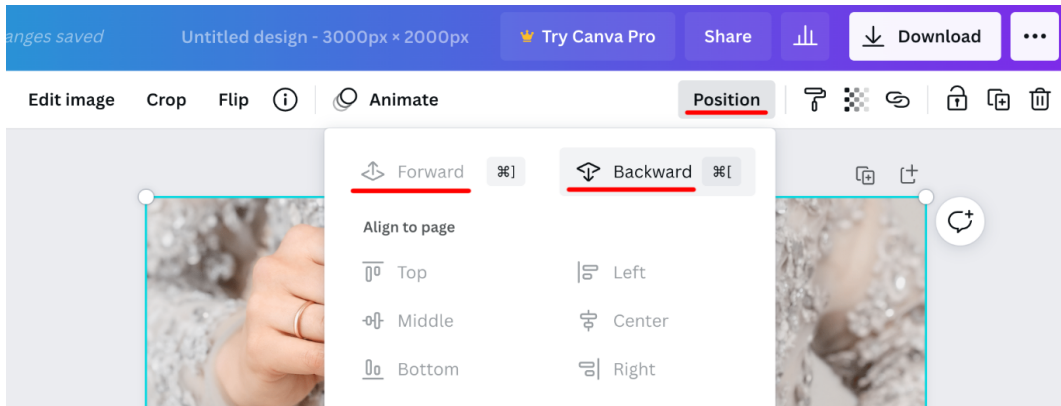
5. Navigate to the product's files on your computer and choose .jpg and .png files. Upload your design the same way. So, you've uploaded three files (.jpg + .png + file with your design) to Canva.

6. Now we'll make a sandwich :) Firstly, click the .jpg image, and it'll be placed on the canvas. Then click the image with your design and scale it. Finally, click the transparent .png image.

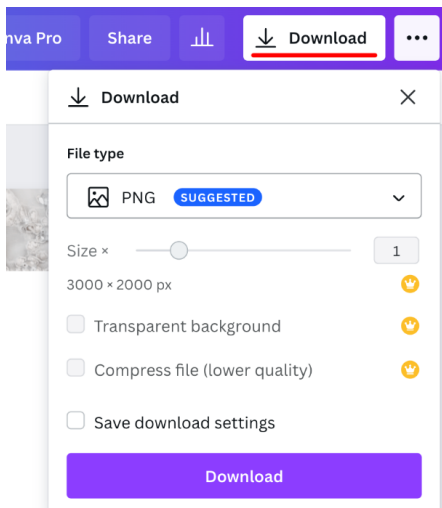


7. Drag your cursor over all elements to select them. Scale them, so they fill the white space. Please note, unlike a psd mockup, there is no cardboard texture in the png file. The design placed in the mockup still looks realistic.

8. If you want to correct the design size, use the Forward/Backward options to move the layer with your design forward, scale, and return it backward.



9. The last step is to save the final image on the computer by clicking Download.
